

# INDUSTRY APPLICATION SOCIETY - OUTSTANDING STUDENT BRANCH CHAPTER AWARDS (IEEE IAS/IES/PELS-OSBCA)-2019

The purpose of this recognition system serves to change the mindset of our student groups, from being number-driven, to becoming value-driven and to acknowledge exemplary student branch chapter activities around Kerala section. The goal is to improve the quality of activities, and to foster knowledge sharing among students. Ultimately, the initiative is targeted at improving student-membership growth. This will encourage and motivate students to continue to innovate and implement meaningful ideas related to IEEE Industry Application Society.

## Purpose

The IA/IE/PELS Outstanding student branch Award aims to recognize the student branch chapter which has done outstanding activities in the chapter for the benefit of the members and the society.

## Eligibility Criteria

1. The Chapter should be active with a minimum of six members and one IAS Advisor. Inviting Award nomination from IEEE IAS/IES/PELS Student Branch Chapters around Kerala (Chapter Should be formed within 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018).
2. The SB chapter should send the **Annual IAS/IES/PELS SBC Report** to Kerala IAS Jt. Chapter Chair with cc to IAS Kerala Chapter Secretary and Vice Chair **before 31st January 2020**.
3. Previous two year winners are not eligible to apply for the award.

## Evaluation Criteria

The judging is primarily on the below criteria

1. Annual IEEE IAS/IES/PELS SB Chapter Report(0-80)
2. The events organized, Technical, Educational, Administrative, others (0-40)
3. The benefits given to members(0-20)
4. Future plans(0-20)
5. IAS/IES/PELS Membership (0-20)
6. Number of IAS/IES/PELS Members (0-10)  
(Professional, student, Graduate student, members)
  - The growth of membership in last two years(Should be included in the SBC Report)  
(0-5)
  - Membership driven initiative & Sustainability of SBC (0-5)

NB: The value of event is more important than its number.
